Visitors are always welcome in our small community. Mass is celebrated every weekday at 10am (except Mon) and our main services are on Saturday at 6.00pm and Sunday at 10.30am. We have some parking spaces within the church grounds and plenty of roadside parking within easy reach. Tea, coffee, biscuits and a chat are on offer after Sunday Mass.

The church building dates from 1929 and has a strong Spanish influence. It can be found on Crow Green, which is a small turning almost opposite Somerfield on the west end of town. Our Parish Priest is Fr Bill Kiely, who lives in the presbytery by the church. We also have frequent visits from Fr Royston Davis, a retired priest living in Tiverton.

Many of our religious and social events make use of our new church hall. This

hall is also available to local groups and families for a small fee. It is also used by our children for their own special liturgy on Sundays.
